Its purpose is to support participants in establishing, and expanding, their personal and academic goals to be a competitive college applicant.

This highly valued program is **free** of charge and designed to expose participants to the breadth of major, college, and career opportunities available to them and to cultivate a college-going mindset for every girl, regardless of circumstance. The College Bound Program will be held on the online platform, Canvas. Participants will participate in interactive live group lessons twice a week, accompanied with small group discussions and individual assignments.



- Must be in 12th grade in the 2021-2022 school year
- Able to commit to the required dates and times listed in table below.
- Reliable internet access and computer use during scheduled program meeting times.

2021 Required College Bound: Grad Lab Program Commitments

Participants accepted into the College Bound Program are <u>required</u> to participate in two live sessions per week, on the online platform, Zoom, for the duration of the four-month program.

In addition to participating in live sessions, participants will be required to complete individual and group assignments and have the opportunity to attend individual advising sessions. Following the conclusion of the College Bound: Grad Lab Program in December, participants will continue to receive individual advising on a monthly basis, invited to join our Mentorship program, and participate in College Shower to see them through the final stages of their senior year, before college.

By submitting this application, the applicant and their parent/guardian have read, understand, and agree that the participant will participate in the following required College Bound sessions, virtually, in observance of the absence policy:

Absence Policy

Participants are required to participate in the live session on Zoom, each week. Each College Bound participant is allowed two excused absences through the duration of the program. All live sessions will be recorded, and available to participants for up to 24 hours should they be unable to attend. In order for the absence to be excused, participants must notify their coordinator and complete a short questionnaire to show they have viewed the recorded lesson. Continuous unexcused absences may result in release from the College Bound: Virtual Grad Lab Program.

We understand that COVID-19 has presented additional obstacles and responsibilities for girls, and their families, that may impact attendance and participation in the program. Please communicate any concerns you may have with your coordinator, as soon as they arise.
