The Literacy Lab program was researched and developed originally through our National Resource Center and a grant from the W.K. Kellogg Foundation. Girls Inc. of Orange County was one of three national pilot sites for the program. At each new site Girls Inc. has been able to bring strong community support including school districts, individual administrators and teachers, and community supporters. Girls Inc. of OC tracks reading levels using a nationally recognized measurement tool: Acadience (formerly known as DIBELS, Dynamic Indicators of Basic Literacy Skills) 98%

By offering Literacy Lab weekly at each site during the school year, participants receive over

35 hours

of literacy activities that align with CA Common Core Standards for English Language and one-on-one reading time in a school year. Girls Inc. of OC hosted
